Content & Methods

Writing a scientific article is part of your thesis. You must then manage several constraints: define the type of scientific article, give yourself an objective, establish a writing plan, self-regulate during writing to maintain your efforts and motivation, and correct yourself.

To meet these needs, this training will be organized into three parts:

Analyze and plan

- taking into account academic standards and types of scientific articles ;
- definition of the objective and content ;
- editorial planning ;
- problematization.

Write and self-regulate

- techniques to ensure consistency and clarity;
- work with the speech of others;
- the art of synthesis;
- management of time, resources and emotions.

Correct and submit your article

- criteria and techniques for self-evaluation of articles ;
- submitting an article step by step.
